37 Sweater

Size S / M / L / XL

Garment measurements: Bust 92/102/112/122 cm (361/4"/401/4"/44"/48")

Length 64 cm (251/4")

Materials: LANGYARNS CARPE DIEM (merino wool, alpaca) 700/750/800/850 g = 14/15/16/17 balls of bronze 714.0211. ADDI knitting needles, size 6mm (US 10, UK 4) and 7mm (US 10.5, UK 2). 1 circular needle in sizes 6mm and 7mm and 1 short circular needle, size 4.5mm (US/UK 7) – 5mm (US 8, UK 6).

Pattern I: 6mm needles: k1, p1.

Pattern II: 7mm needles: moss st: Row 1: k1, p1. Rows 2 + 4: knit the sts as they

face you. **Row 3:** p1, k1, i.e. staggered with row 1. Rep rows 1 – 4.

Pattern III: 7mm needles: cable to the right over 8 (9) sts, according to chart. The

chart shows the RS rows. On WS knit the sts as they appear. Rep rows 1

– 12.

Pattern IV: 7mm needles: cable over 14 (16) sts, according to chart. The chart shows

the RS rows. On WS knit the sts as they appear. Repeat rows 1 - 12.

Pattern V: 7mm needles: cable to the left over 8 (9) sts, according to chart. The chart

shows the RS rows. On WS knit the sts as they appear. Rep rows 1 - 12.

Tip 1: Work the edge sts in pattern, when making up sew seams just half a stitch in from the edge.

Tip 2: Fully fashioned dec 1: Right edge = 1 edge st, sl1, k1, psso. Left edge: k2tog, 1 edge st. **Tip 3: Fully fashioned dec 2:** Right edge: (RS) = k2tog, 1 edge st, (WS) = 1 edge st, p2tog. Left edge: (RS) = 1 edge st, sl1, k1, psso, (WS) = p2tog tbl, 1 edge st.

Gauge: Pattern II, 7mm needles:

16 sts = $10 \text{ cm } (4^{\circ}) \text{ wide.}$ 20 rows = $10 \text{ cm } (4^{\circ}) \text{ long.}$

Patterns III - V, 7mm needles:

22 sts = 10 cm (4") wide. 20 rows = 10 cm (4") long.

Back: Cast on 91/99/107/115 sts with 6mm needles. Knit in pattern I. After 5 cm (2"), on a WS row, inc 7 sts evenly over the 68 sts in the centre = 98/106/114/122 sts. Now with 7mm needles, distribute pattern as foll: 1 edge st, 10/14/18/22 sts pattern II, 9 sts pattern III (A-a), 14 sts pattern IV (A-a), 8 sts pattern III (B-a), 14 sts

pattern IV (**A-a**), 9 sts pattern V (**A-a**), 10/14/18/22 sts pattern II, 1 edge st. **Armholes**: At 43/42/41/39 cm $(17''/16'/_2''/16'/_4''/15'/_4'')$ from the cast-on (measured hanging) work fully fashioned dec, dec 1 st at each end of every other row 9/10/11/12 times (see tip 2) = 80/86/92/98 sts. Continue working in pattern as set, after the edge st k1 (on WS p1) and before the edge st k1 (on WS p1). **Shoulders:** When armhole measures 18/19/20/22 cm $(7''/7'/_2''/8''/8^3/_4'')$ cast off at each end of every other row: 8 sts twice + 9 sts once / 9 sts 3 times / 9 sts once + 10 sts twice / 10 sts twice + 11 sts once. **Neck:** At the same time, as you begin shoulder shaping, cast off the middle 18/20/22/24 sts and then either side, at neck edge on every other row cast off 3 sts twice.

Front: Knit as for back. **Neck:** When front measures 55 cm (21¾") cast off the middle 16/18/20/22 sts and after 2 rows cast off 3 sts at neck edge, then work fully fashioned dec, dec 1 st at same edge on **every row** 4 times (see tip 3). Shape shoulders at the same length and in the same way as for back.

Sleeves: Cast on 39/43/47/51 sts with 6mm needles. Knit in pattern I. After 12 cm $(4\frac{3}{4}\text{"})$, inc 11 sts evenly over a WS row = 50/54/58/62 sts. Now with 7mm needles, **distribute pattern** as foll: 1 edge st, 16/18/20/22 sts pattern II, 16 sts pattern IV $(\mathbf{B} - \mathbf{b})$, 16/18/20/22 sts pattern II, 1 edge st. At 32 cm $(12\frac{1}{2}\text{"})$ from the cast-on, inc 1 st at each end of the row, then in the same way again at each end of every 6th row 3 times = 58/62/66/70 sts. Incorporate the new sts into pattern II. **Sleeve cap:** When sleeve measures 44 cm $(17\frac{1}{4}\text{"})$ work fully fashioned dec, dec 1 st at each end of every other row 9/9/10/10 times (see tip 2). Loosely cast off rem sts pattern-wise when sleeve cap reaches a length of 9/9/10/10 cm $(3\frac{1}{2}\text{"}/3\frac{1}{2}\text{"}/4\text{"}/4\text{"})$.

Finishing: Close seams, leaving about 24 cm ($9\frac{1}{2}$ ") open at the bottom of each side seam. **Neckband:** With 6mm circular needle, pick up 80/84/88/92 sts (front = 48/50/52/54 sts, back = 32/34/36/38 sts). **At the same time,** on WS, hold a thinner needle inside and make a yo over the cord of this needle after you pick up each st = 80/84/88/92 sts on RS and 80/84/88/92 sts on the inside. On RS work 2 rnd in k and on the inside work 2 rnds in k. Then on RS knit tog sts from both needles = 80/84/88/92 sts. Now with 6mm needles, knit pattern I in the rnd. When collar measures 6 cm ($2\frac{1}{4}$ ") continue with 7mm needles. Loosely cast off all sts pattern-wise when collar measures 16 cm ($6\frac{1}{4}$ "). Set in sleeves.
