#### 29 RANYA

#### **Triangular shawl**

Measurements approximately 2634" x 6334" (68 cm x 162 cm)

**Materials: LANGYARNS NOËLLE** (merino extrafine mulesing-free, nylon) 125 g = 5 balls of gold 1134.0050. ADDI knitting needles, size US 2.5 (3 mm).

## **PATTERN STITCHES**

## Seed st (I):

US 2.5 (3 mm) needles: Seed st:

Row 1 (RS): \* k1, p1, rep from \*.

Row 2 (WS): \* p1, k1, rep from \* (the sts alternate with the sts of row 1).

Rep rows 1 & 2.

## Stockinette st (II):

US 2.5 (3 mm) needles: Stockinette st = knit on RS, purl on WS.

## Reverse stockinette st (III):

US 2.5 (3 mm) needles: Reverse stockinette st = purl on RS, knit on WS.

Pattern sequence: chessboard pattern, according to chart (7 sts and 8 rows per square).

#### Gauge: Over pattern sequence, US 2.5 (3 mm) needles:

29 sts = 4" (10 cm), 40 rows = 4" (10 cm).

# SHAWL

Cast on 9 sts with US 2.5 (3 mm) needles.

Now work **pattern sequence** as shown in the chart, work 1 edge st at the beginning and end of every row.

For side shaping, cast on 7 sts at the beginning and end of the 8th row.

Rep inc every 8 rows 33 times. Incorporate the new sts into the pattern.

When all increases have been completed you will have 471 sts.

Continue working until shawl measures about  $26\frac{3}{4}$ " (68 cm) from the cast-on (after 272 rows), then loosely bind off all sts in pattern.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to size.
